

Pre-Drywall Orientation

A Pre-Drywall Orientation (PDO) will take place once the construction of your new home has progressed through the framing and rough mechanical stages. The PDO is a great way for you to ensure that the requested structural changes for your new home have been accounted for. Please bring your Agreement of Purchase and Sale and list of purchased extras with you. Our site superintendent will also take this opportunity to point out features of our construction methods and answer any questions that you may have. It is important to note that at this stage there is no longer an opportunity to make new changes to your home design.

In order to maintain a safe environment on our construction sites, the orientation is limited to two people and children under the age of sixteen are not permitted. We ask that you wear appropriate footwear and we will provide a hard hat for your use during the orientation. Please do not visit your home at any time without a representative from Marz Homes. Our job sites are strictly regulated by the Ministry of Labour and we are emphatic about enforcing safe practices at all times. Therefore, anyone found on a job site without a Marz Homes representative may be escorted off due to Health & Safety regulations.

A representative from our office will contact you directly to set up an appointment for your PDO which will take place between the hours of 8:00 am and 3:30 pm Monday through Friday. We look forward to showing you the Marz quality that is going into your new home.
